

There is a story told of an event about a century ago. In 1930, the communist leader Bukharin left Moscow to travel to Kiev. His mission was to make a speech to a huge assembly of people about atheism. For about an hour he ridiculed, made every point and argument he could to convince his listeners to leave Christianity behind, and turned to leave the podium. He was confident that he convinced everyone there to walk away from their faith. There is no way their simplistic faith could withstand what he just finished telling them.

So before sitting down, he turned back around and asked the crowd if there were any questions. One solitary man raised his hand, and Bukharin invited him to the stage. So, the man made his way to the front, climbed the steps onto the stage, and went to stand close to Bukharin. The audience was silent, and the man looked from one side of the crowd to the other.

At last, he then shouted the ancient orthodox greeting, "CHRIST IS RISEN!" and the crowd rose to their feet and roared the response, "HE IS RISEN INDEED!"

We are living in a day when more and more people seem to be doubting this truth of our faith, that Jesus is risen. At times we have to admit that it is easy to just



give in, to remain silent, to lose sight of what God has done for us in Jesus Christ. But Easter is that time to shout to the world that our Savior is alive, that death could not stop him, and that we are called to follow the risen Savior.

My prayer for you is that you will be able to join the Body of Christ this Easter in proclaiming this good news! We serve a risen Savior!
